

# Mixed Doubles Curling Challenge --- Curling Club Limmattal --- 15. - 17. December 2017



Competition Rules - All games will be played according to the WCF rules valid at the time of the tournament.  
 The Mixed Doubles Curling Challenge will be played with 15 teams, split into three pools of 5 teams for round robin play.  
 The top six teams overall qualify for the playoffs.

First End Choice of "rock-placement"/Stone assignment

- Prior to the first game, a coin-flip will determine which team has the First End Choice of "rock-placement".
- For all other round robin games the team with the better LSD from the last game has the "First End Choice" (If it's tied = coin toss)
- For all the playoff-games, the higher ranked team in the overall-ranking has the "First End Choice".
- The team without "First End Choice" has the choice of stone-colours.

Extra ends for all games

- If teams are tied after 8 ends, there will be one extra end. The team without last rock in extra end wins, if the extra is blanked.
- In the Final, extra end will be played until the game is decided.

Last Stone Draws (LSD)

All round robin games are followed by Last Stone Draws according to the WCF rules.  
 Stones covering the Button will be scored 0.00cm!! (NO two point measurement)  
 (first rock clockwise, second rock counter-clockwise, after the round robin a variation of one rotation per player has to occur.)

Ranking

At the end of the round robin the overall-ranking will be drawn by following criteria:

1. Win/Loss record
2. DSC (The single least favourable result is automatically eliminated when calculating the average distance.)

Playoffs

- The TOP 2 teams in the overall-ranking, are directly qualified for the semi-finals.
- The teams ranked 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th in the overall-ranking are qualified for the Q1/Q2.
